Order Extending Judges' Deadline to File Financial Disclosure Forms

On March 20, 2020, the United States Secretary of Treasury announced that, at the direction of President Donald Trump, the federal tax filing deadline will be extended to July 15, 2020. On March 23, 2020, the Governor of the State of Kansas, Laura Kelly, signed Executive Order #20-13 which extended the state tax filing deadline to July 15, 2020.

Under Rule 3.15, Canon 3 of the Kansas Code of Judicial Conduct (Supreme Court Rule 601B), a Kansas judge must submit various information for the preceding calendar year to the Office of Judicial Administration by April 15 of each year. Due to the extensions of the state and federal tax filing deadlines, the deadline for a judge to submit his or her financial disclosure form for calendar year 2019 to the Office of Judicial Administration is extended to July 15, 2020.
