Availability of Electronic Case Initiation for Appellate Cases

In June 2024, under Administrative Order 2024-CC-060, the court rescinded Administrative Orders 2023-CC-073 and 2023-CC-074 entirely, and rescinded Administrative Order 2023-RL-077 for service of all documents other than those filed for appellate case initiation. Through this order we rescind the case initiation provisions in Administrative Order 2023-RL-077 and order the use of efiling for case initiation as set out below.

- Effective August 23, 2024, a Kansas attorney may efile any document necessary to initiate a case in an appellate court.
- Effective September 3, 2024, a Kansas attorney must resume mandatory efiling under the requirements of Supreme Court Rule 1.14 for all documents, including those necessary to initiate a case in an appellate court.
- Effective September 3, 2024, this order rescinds Administrative Order 2023-RL-077 for service of all documents.

The clerk of the appellate courts must process all paper filings for case initiation postmarked on or before September 2, 2024, under 2024-CC-060. Beginning September 3, 2024, under Supreme Court Rule 1.14, the clerk of the appellate courts will not process a paper filing submitted by a Kansas attorney.
