Rule 713

REFERRALS AND EVALUATIONS

- (a) Generally. During a character and fitness investigation, the prior conduct of an applicant for admission to the Kansas bar may demonstrate the need for further inquiry into the applicant's substanceabuse history or mental health. The admissions attorney, Attorney Admissions Review Committee, or Board of Law Examiners may take any of the following actions when further inquiry is needed:
 - (1) refer an applicant to the Kansas Lawyers Assistance Program;
 - (2) select a qualified professional to conduct a substance-abuse evaluation of the applicant; and
 - (3) in an exceptional circumstance, select a qualified professional to conduct a psychological or psychiatric evaluation.
- (b) **Evaluation Expense**. The expense of an evaluation conducted under this rule will be paid out of the bar admission fee fund.
